Farthest North Pickleball Club - Open Play Guidelines

General Guidelines:

- > All playing levels are welcome.
- Separate beginners and challenge courts may be designated during the 10:00 - 12:00 open playtime and during the official Club times at the SRC.
- All players are expected to support and nurture new players. Remember, you too, were a "newbie" at one time.

Under 6 paddles in line:

- Winners may stay and split or they may stay together if that is acceptable to the in-coming players.
- > The next two from the queue will come on to replace losing players.
- An individual winning 3 games in a row will come off and place their paddle at the end of the queue unless there are no paddles in the queue.
- If you are next up in the queue, and you prefer to skip that court, then you will move your paddle to the end of the queue.
- If you wish to play with a particular person, stack your paddles at the end of the queue. Only 2 paddles per stack.

6 paddles or more in line:

- When a game is finished, all four players will come off the court to be replaced by the next four players in the queue.
- With 6 or more paddles in the queue, players may stack 4 paddles at the end of the queue.
